## Our Priorities Session 22/23

- Our overall attendance will increase from 89% to 92%
- Our attainment in Literacy will increase to 58% and in Numeracy to 61%
- Continue to develop our digital culture to support learning, teaching and assessment
- (Nursery) to develop the professional skills and knowledge of all practitioners

#### Attainment Session 22/23

- Our overall attainment has increased from 52% to 60% in Literacy. It has increased from 58% to 67% in Numeracy.
- Our attendance rate for this session is 90%. We decreased our unauthorised absences from 4.4% to 3.5%.

## Nursery Session 22/23

- Care Inspection in September 2022 identified our care, play and learning as good, our setting as very good, our leadership as good and our staff team as very good.
- There were no areas identified for further improvement
- We will continue to use our self-evaluation processes to ensure we continue to improve the experiences for our children
