

Free Range Project Parent/Carer Referral Information



What is Free Range?

Free Range is an entirely outdoor play experience for children from P1 to P5 and is designed to promote your child's health & wellbeing through outdoor play in a natural environment.

Free Range provides support to families during school holiday periods and is delivered by Fife Council's Play Practice Development Team based within Early Years, Education Directorate. Free Range takes place at a woodland site within Chancefield, on Falkland Estate, Fife.

Children are referred to Free Range in consultation with parent/carers by professionals such as a teacher, health visitor, social worker and other agencies.

Playing outdoors at Free Range will provide your child with challenge and adventure, through fun and exciting outdoor play experiences to explore the natural environment. Supported by experienced staff children will gain a greater knowledge of the outdoors, increasing their confidence through developing new skills and friendships.

What happens next?

The referrer will initially inform the parent/carer the outcome of the referral. If successful, the Free Range Team will write out to the parent/carer to confirm the child's place in writing and provide further details.
