1. Chair's welcome and report.

- Welcome to parents, especially new parents coming to the AGM for the first time.
- PC's purpose to support Mrs Nash and the School community: (1) to provide a link between Mrs Nash's staff and the parent body (especially through the class reps); (2) social and fundraising activities of the PC (e.g. projector in school hall; painting in playground).
- With thanks to Catriona Yates, we have secured a donation of £5000 from the community trust to go towards the provision of outdoor learning.
- PC meetings will be online (via zoom) this academic year.
- We need to support Social committee better Linsey and Louise have done a huge amount on their own, but we want to support them more as a PC.
- Anya has been developing the 2nd hand school uniform in the school.
- Supporting staff and Mrs Nash with outdoor learning (e.g. fundraising / parent helpers).

2. Treasurer's report.

- This year we have spent about £2,000 (including £1,000 for school books; £400 to help P7 week; and other amounts for various social events). We have raised £2,503.
- In the bank, £4,056.68. £241 to add (from the raison fund-raising).
- Louise has managed to sort out the online banking.

3. Headteacher's report.

- The PC take the same roles and responsibilities as in any other school, but we are a faith community, and you are part of that community in our school. The PC's role to support the vision, aims, and values of us as a catholic school, which comes from our gospel values (keeping Christ at the centre). Collaboration between the home, the school, and our parish.
- We have a new theme centred around St Francis (we are named after the Franciscans 'the greyfriars'). We want to make our values more alive. A new Francis acrostic: Standing Together in Faith Respect Achievement Nurture Community Inclusion Sustainability!
- The children are very proud of their school. After the lockdown, this is a real opportunity to reset, and work together on our values.
- Covid: the covid restrictions are currently remaining pretty much the same.
- Standards and Qualities Report (what we have achieved).
- School Improvement Plan (what we are going to do in the next academic year): (1) implementation of consistent learning and assessment (particularly in reading and writing); (2) developing partnership across the school as a community of faith and learning (difficult to sustain a community online; how to rebuild our community, and involve parents more); (3) promoting the well being of our children, parents, and staff.
- Some of the things we will be doing: literacy; maths; RE; laudato si (and environment work, eco committee etc); green flag; outdoor learning; health and well being; social subjects; Lenten fundraiser; shoe boxes for the elderly.

- Bringing back clubs and normality for the children: e.g. basketball, chess, after school football (for boys and girls); and restart tuck shop. Peer mediation training for P7s (2 day training to help).
- Outdoor learning. Confirmation of £5,000 grant in the bank account. More updates on outdoor learning in due course.
