1. Minutes of the last PC meeting (21 September 2022) Approved.

2. Headteacher's report

(i) <u>HMI visit.</u> Lead inspector + team of 4 are doing a short and focused model of inspection (Mon. lunchtime to Wed. lunchtime). The children will shine as the stars that they are. Our children are very articulate, and they will tell them all about our school.

(ii) <u>P7 'bikeability'</u>: re-starting. P7 will do 3 sessions; then P6, then P5 (for level 1); then back to P7 for level 2 (4 sessions) and P6 (4 sessions). Bikeability are providing the trainers; 2 staff representatives; if any parents would like to be trained for this (esp. level 2), please let Mrs Crompton know.

(iii) New gate is now open. There was notification in the newsletter. Not sure about uptake and usage.

(iv) P1-2, and our P2-3, and our P3-4: these will have a 'shared start', so that mums, dads, grandparents, can come and do some shared activities (probably week starting 14 Nov. or the following).

(v) P1-3 will be doing a nativity.

(vi) 6 Dec. trip to the Byre (£10 per child). Parent Council will pay 50%, so it is £5 per child. (vii) 14 Dec. 1.30: Nativity and Carol Service

(viii) 15 Dec. Christmas mass (10am) and Christmas fayre (6-8pm). Parents and parishioners welcome. Tea, coffee, and mince pie, biscuits. PC will also do a raffle for Christmas fayre (money goes to the school).

(ix) 19-21 Dec. Christmas parties. Party bags for the children (PC). (x) Christmas lunch and Christmas jumpers.
