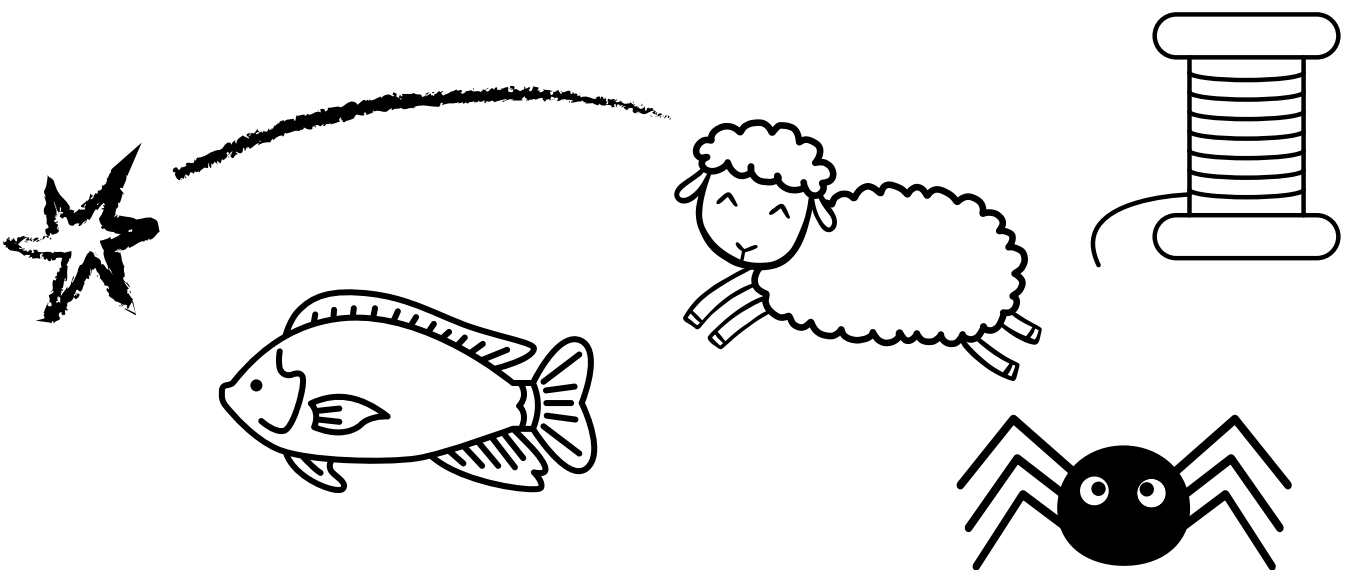
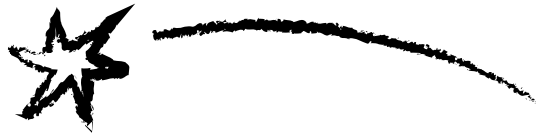

are.

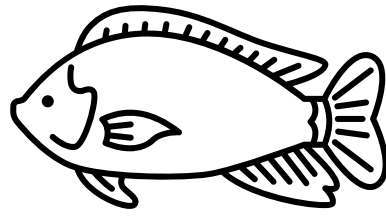
Up above the world so

Once I caught a fish alive,

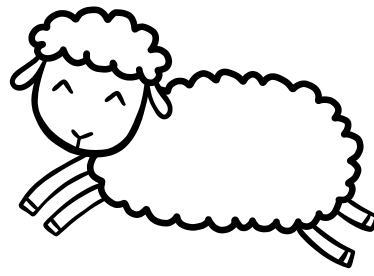
Six, seven, eight, nine, ten,

right.



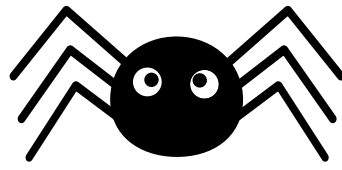
Baa, baa, black sheep.

the lane.

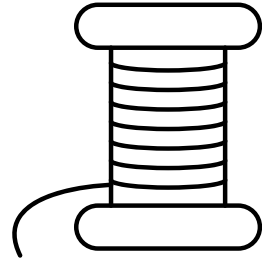


Incey, wincey spider.

climbed up the spout again

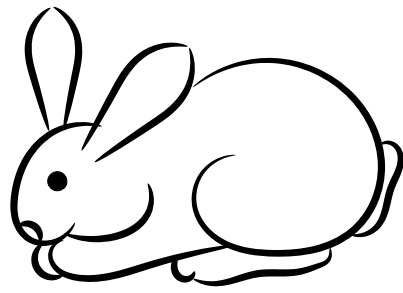


Wind the Bobbin Up

Sleeping bunnies

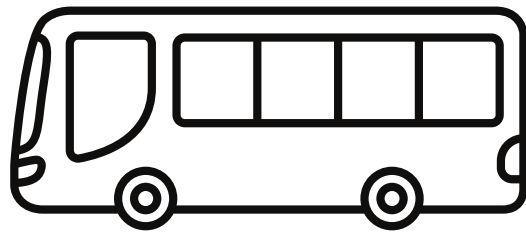
See the little bunnies sleeping til

The Wheels on the Bus

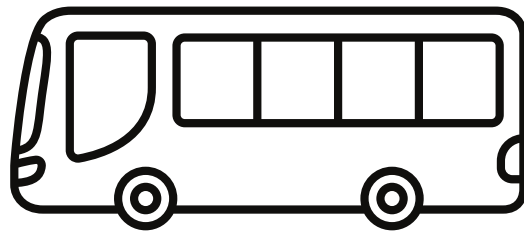
The wheels on the bus go round

the driver on the bus says "Tickets please, tickets please, tickets please.

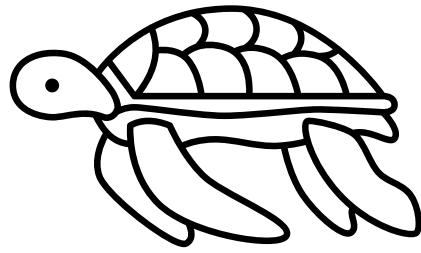
The driver on the bus says tickets please all day long.

Tiny Tim

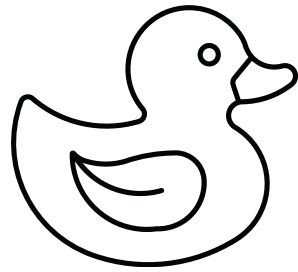
I had a little turtle, his name was

5 Little Ducks

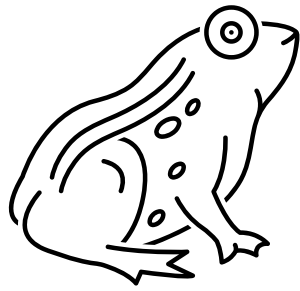
5 little ducks went swimming one day,

back.

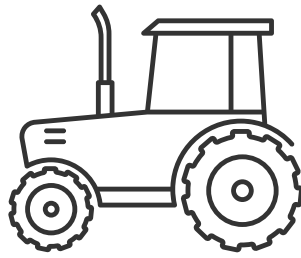


3 Little Speckled Frogs
