




How I wonder what you are.


Up above the world so high,

Thank you said the master, thank you said the dame and thank you said the little boy who lives down the lane.






Incey, wincey spider.

Out came the sunshine and dried up all the rain, And Incy Wincy spider climbed up the spout again






### Wind the Bobbin Up

shall we wake them with a merry tune.


Oh so still, are they will. wake up soon.

The wheels on the bus go round and round, round and round, round and round, the wheels on the bus go round and round all day long.


The wipers on the bus go swish, swish, swish, swish, swish, swish, swish.

The driver on the bus says tickets please all day long.








#### Little Peter Rabbit
