

## Kennoway Primary School- Standards & Quality Report 2024-25

### Context of the School

<b>Demographic</b>	<p>Kennoway is a recognised area of deprivation, which is reflected in our average SIMD of 2.8.</p> <p>46% of our families live in SIMD 1 &amp; 2.</p> <p>Our FME, based on our current P6 and P7 data, is 32%.</p> <p>Our current roll in total is 486, which includes 377 children across P1-7, 85 children in main Nursery and 24 children in Early Entrants, which has the capacity to support 30 children.</p> <p>Main Nursery operates on a term time model whilst Early Entrants operates on a 49-week model.</p> <p>26.3% of children in P1-7 have an identified Additional Support Need. In addition, 19 of our children have English as an additional language and we currently support 5 children who are Care Experienced by their home local authority. 8 children have an Armed Forces background.</p>
