This week we have been learning about the water cycle. There are 4 stages of the water cycle; evaporation, condensation, precipitation and collection. Evaporation is when the water turns into water vapour (a gas). Then the gas turns into liquid and collects as a cloud; this is called condensation. Precipitation is when the water gets too heavy and falls from the clouds. Rain, snow and hail are all types of precipitation. The water collects from streams and rivers into the sea and the cycle starts again.

In literacy we have been learning about past tense verbs. Verbs are actions or doing words, most of the words end in ed.

Try becomes tried Hop becomes hopped Sometimes there are exceptions; Run becomes ran Hide becomes hid Is becomes was

We have learned some spelling rules for adding ed and have been writing in the past.

For art we have decorated the hall for the disco with Halloween crafts with p6/7. We were making skeletons, ghosts, bats, cobwebs and pumpkins. We watched a video about how to make moving bats and how to cut chains of pumpkins, ghosts and bats. We used our investigating and observation skills to figure the steps to make the skeletons and stain glassed cobwebs. The hall looked spookily good for our disco.

We have started learning about space. We know that the sun is a start and if it blew up we wouldn't know for around 10 minutes. At home, we have been asked to look at the moon and think about how it looks like it changes shape in the sky. We will be discussing this next week.
