

This week we have been continuing to develop our skills in note taking. We have been researching different planets in our solar system and then using our notes to write a report. We organised our notes under headings and used these as subheadings in our final report. Next steps include refining our researching so we can focus our notes to particular areas we want to find out more about.

We had a lovely open afternoon; sharing our learning and strategies for numeracy across the school, on Thursday. To prepare, we had to decide which strategy we would want to share with our adults from home. We have been practising these strategies and breaking them down into step by step instructions which we used to create a poster. We then used these posters to teach our visitors how to calculate using that strategy. We hope you enjoyed the afternoon.

For PE this week we have been in astronaut training! We have been learning about how and why astronauts train for going to and from space. We have been tracking our progress this week for agility and speed. We have been working in groups to complete an obstacle course (using different techniques like bunny hops or side stepping) and using a stop watch to record the time taken. We recorded the results on a data sheet and will use this data to track our progress.
