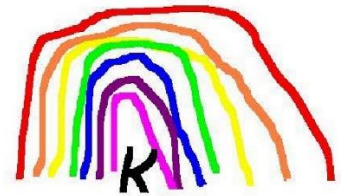


# Kilmaron Newsletter
