We have an extended learning partnership coming up on the 3rd February and are looking for as many parents as possible to join a parent group at 10.30. This is your chance to share with our Head of Service (Angela Logue) your thoughts on our school and we welcome all feedback.

All parents will have received an email from Fife council as part of their parent wise survey. This is for all schools in Fife and part of their evaluation process. Staff and pupils will also receive surveys, and this data helps drive changes at higher levels and lets us reflect on what we can do better or celebrate what we are doing well. Please let us know if you need further links of information.

Devices

We have now received our pupil devices. Every pupil has a device with a robust case. We are currently updating them and ensuring each pupil has apps installed that are relevant for them. Our wifi upgrade hasn't happened yet so this is taking some time! We hope to be up and running in the next week or so. Staff have received some training and will have more over the coming weeks. We will introduce the devices to the pupils and will be creating supports to help them use them safely. This might be social stories, visuals or direct teaching. Although the devices have firewalls and safety features included, we want to ensure our pupils stay safe online.



Each device can be linked to your own device at home. Parents who choose to have the devices at home can control screen time and what apps the children access through an app called JAMF. I have shared an information leaflet about this but will share more in due course.
