Literacy	Reading Our class novel this term is 'The Explorer' by Katherine Rundell.	 We are developing strategies to help us read and understand texts. In particular we will be working on the Literacy Key questions relating to prediction, character and setting. We are learning about different genres of texts. We are extending our vocabulary by finding out the meaning of words linked to our reading, spelling and topic learning using dictionaries.
	Writing	 We are learning to write personal recounts, with a focus on sequencing and on sharing our opinions. We are learning to write imaginative texts, with a focus on description of setting, character and plot. We will also be developing our use of Tier 2 vocabulary in our writing through QI writing. We are learning to apply our ongoing spelling work to all areas of literacy. In Grammar we are developing our use of punctuation with a focus on sentences, full stops, question and exclamation marks, and paragraphs.
	Listening & Talking	 We are learning to take part in discussion, listening and sharing our ideas. We are learning to respond to and ask literal, inferential and evaluative questions about what we listen to or watch.
Numeracy	l	 We are developing our using of rounding and estimating. We are learning to use our knowledge of rounding to help with calculating and to check our answers. We are learning about the place value of number, working with 3/4/5-digit numbers, and explaining the link between a digit, its place and its value.

	 We are learning to use a variety of mental and written strategies in addition and subtraction. In Information Handling, we are exploring ways in which data is collected, sorted and presented, and are learning to ask and answer questions about the information it contains. We are learning to interpret and draw conclusions from a variety of graphs and tables. We are learning that different civilisations have used different ways to record numbers. We are continuing to use Sumdog to improve our mental maths fluency at our own level.
Social Studies Our class topic/interdisciplinary learning focus is the Tropical Rainforest.	 We are learning to contrast our local area with a different area (tropical rainforest). We are learning to measure and record weather and explore climate zones around the world. We are learning to consider the environmental impact of human activity, and ways we can live in a more environmentally responsible way. We are learning to compare land use in our local area with a contrasting area, and discover how the physical features influence land use and living things.
RME	We are learning to identify the beliefs, celebrations and places of worship in Islam.
Science & Technology	 We are learning to distinguish between living, non-living and once living things. We are learning to identify and classify living things. We are learning about food chains and how animals and plants depend on each other for food.
Health & Wellbeing, including PE	 Through the development of our class charter, we are learning to exercise our rights to safety and to learn, and to respect the rights of others. We are learning about the characteristics of a Growth Mindset, and how to approaches challenges in our learning with ambition and perseverance. We are learning characteristics of a good friend. We are learning to recognise and name emotions and feelings. We are developing our ball skills through football and basketball. We are learning to work with others well in a team.
Expressive Arts	 Music - We are learning to recognise features of Soul and Gospel music. We are learning to respond to music, recognising structure, discussing what instruments we can hear

	 and giving our opinion. We are learning to sing and play music, using performance directions (tuned percussion). Art - We are learning to create patterns using some of the visual elements- shape, line and colour. We are learning to use the visual element of line through creating fine line drawings.
Digital Literacy/technology	 We are learning to use Glow to access learning tasks and resources. We are learning to add text and pictures to documents (Word, Powerpoint). We are learning to order and display data through Excel.
Languages	 We are developing our knowledge of French vocabulary used during classroom routines. We are developing our knowledge of French greetings, in listening and responding to questions.
Outdoor Education	 We are learning to compare our outdoor environment to the Tropical Rainforest. We are learning to use objects in our outdoor environment to create art and structures. We are learning to work as a team and strengthen our problem-solving skills.
