Literacy	Reading	 We are continuing to develop our fluency, expression, pace and understanding of punctuation and dialogue in reading aloud. We are continuing to develop our range of skills and strategies to help us read and understand texts. We will use these skills to answer 'Literacy Key' tasks. We are learning to find and select information from factual texts, using layout and content to help us. We are learning to acknowledge our sources independently. We will use our skills relating to factual texts as we research our personal projects. We are learning to ask, answer and create a range of questions about a text. Our P6/7 reading and comprehension learning this term will be based around the graphic novel 'When Stars are Scattered'.
	Writing	 We are learning to write discursive texts. We are learning to write information reports. We are learning to write science reports. We are learning to write graphic texts- story boards and comics. In Grammar we are also learning about prefixes/ suffixes, openers/ conjunctions, and plurals, as well as revising key grammar learning from the year (e.g. apostrophes for possession and contractions, colons and speech marks.) We are continuing to apply our ongoing spelling work to all areas of literacy.

	Listening & Talking	 We are learning to proofread and edit pieces of writing. We are continuing to develop our tools for writing through QI Writing methodology- our focus this term will be creating sentences of different lengths and structures, by using a variety of punctuation and conjunctions. We are learning to create factual texts through researching and presenting our personal projects,
		 giving a personal response that shows some analysis. We are developing our knowledge of and confidence in using features of spoken language such as pace, eye contact, tone, gesture and expression. We are learning to use resources effectively to support and enhance communication when giving a talk.
Numeracy		 We are learning to work confidently with decimal fractions to sequence, order and use them with the 4 operations. We are continuing to develop our mental maths fluency at our own level. We are learning to carry out calculations involving money to work out profit and loss in buying and selling. We are learning to budget for spending We are learning about advantages/ disadvantages of using credit/ debit card We are learning about length, perimeter, area, weight and volume. We are learning to calculate the area of squares, rectangles and right-angled triangles. We are investigating probability and chance.
RME		We are learning about significant figures and celebrations in Judaism.
Science & Technology		 We are learning about some of the substances that make up the Earth's surface. We will compare some of their characteristics and uses. We are learning about magnetic, electrostatic and gravitational forces, and are exploring their practical applications. We are learning to carry out scientific experiments.
Health & Wellbeing, including PE		 We are developing fitness, stamina, strength and control through athletics. We are developing our striking/ fielding skills through rounders. We will continue to develop our teamwork skills,

	 good communication and sportsmanship. We are continuing to develop our understanding of resilience through our Assembly programme. We will be carrying out our RSHP learning for the year- more information about what this involves for different year groups will be sent separately and is available on the RSHP website. We are learning about safety online.
Expressive Arts	 Music We are learning to sing and will have opportunities to perform as part of our end of term Assembly. We are learning to compose, inspired by our Outer Space learning, as part of the 'Musical Universe' project.
	 Art We will be deepening our knowledge and understanding about the work of other artists and be able to discuss confidently their style. We will be responding to the artist work through discussing thoughts and feelings their work provokes. We will be using a wide variety of media to create our interpretation of art work, inspired by the artists.
Digital Literacy/technology	 We are learning to create digital animal with sound. We will be developing a range of basic problemsolving skills by building simple programs to carry out a given task, using an appropriate coding language We will be creating, developing and evaluating computing solutions in response to a design challenge. We will learn how to plan, implement, create, share and extend our ideas whilst creating micro bit projects.
Languages	 We are developing our knowledge of French vocabulary to discuss foods, our hobbies and preferences. We will learn some Spanish vocabulary (greetings, introductions)
Outdoor Education	 We will be completing tasks for the RSPB Wild Challenge Award- rock pooling, beach clean, upcycling for nature and Look Closer. We will be exploring the trees, flowers and bushes growing in the local woodland and using digital technology to produce 'Identification Sheets'. We will be sing the outdoor environment to carry out art activities.
