

Snowman Tessellation Task


You might find tiling around a sink in your home or school. Mathematicians call this pattern 'tessellation'. Tessellation is when one or more shapes are repeated to make a pattern and there are no gaps between them or overlaps.





Let's try to draw a tessellation using a snowman shape. You will need a ruler and a sharp pencil.

First, carefully copy the snowman shape.








Snowman Tessellation Task
