| 2 Rhymes with line 4; four beats | Rummaging around for hat, scarf and gloves |
| 3 Internal rhyme; four beats | Tucking in trousers and putting on wellies, wrapping up warm |
| 4 Rhymes with line 2; four beats | Rushing to the door and going outside, feeling the cold air |

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Using the Structure to Extend the Poem **Ideas**

Verse 8

| Line Number | Ideas for this Line |
|--|---|
| 1 Four beats | Opening the door and feeling the wall of heat |
| 2 Rhymes with line 4; four beats | Taking off soggy and wet gloves, coat, hat, scarf and wellies |
| 3 Internal rhyme; four beats | Mum or Dad has made a hot chocolate |
| 4 Rhymes with line 2; four beats | Curl up on the settee in front of the fire with a hot chocolate, slippers and dog or cat curled up too |
