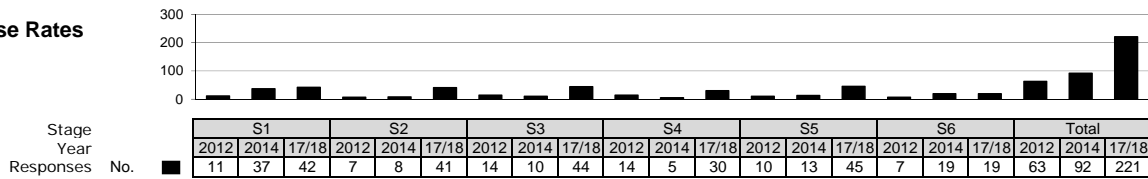

The wording of some questions has been refined since the last survey, therefore trend data should be interpreted with caution. Affected questions have been shaded in the data tables.

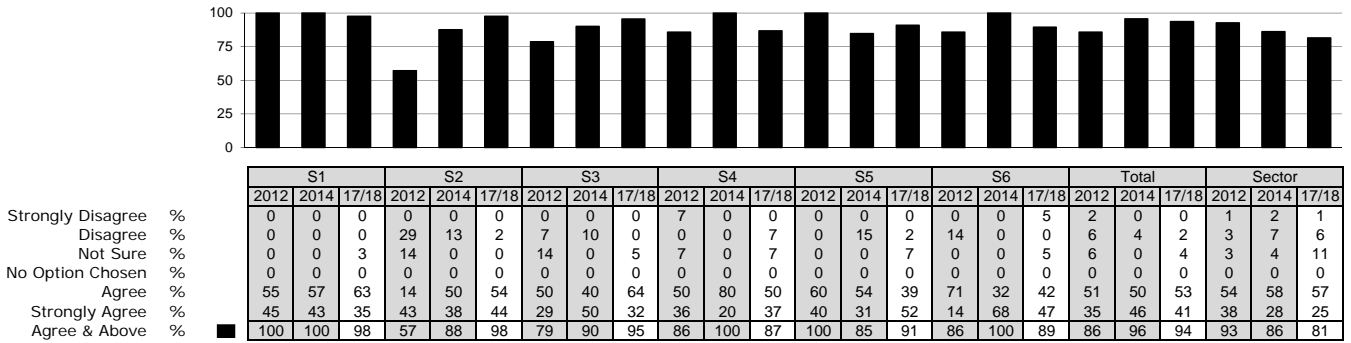

This report compares your school results to the overall secondary sector results.

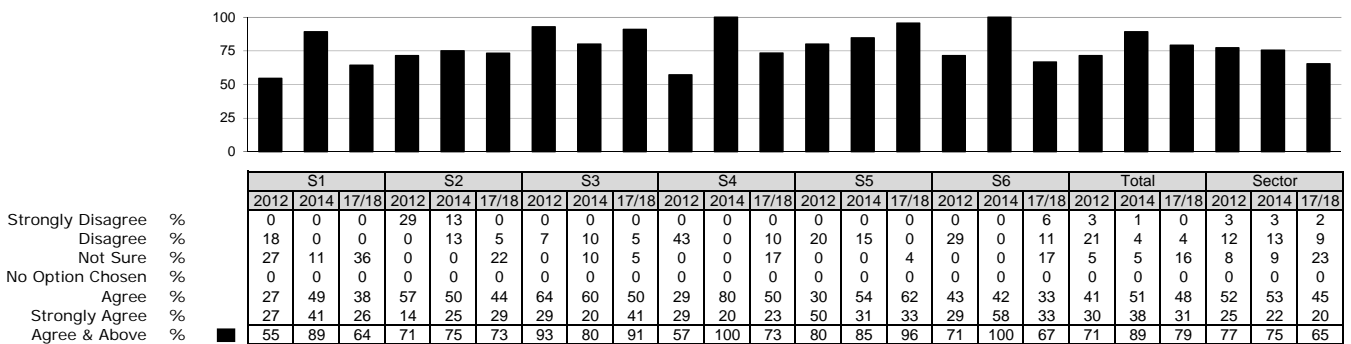
The following charts show the results for 'Agree' and 'Strongly Agree' combined.

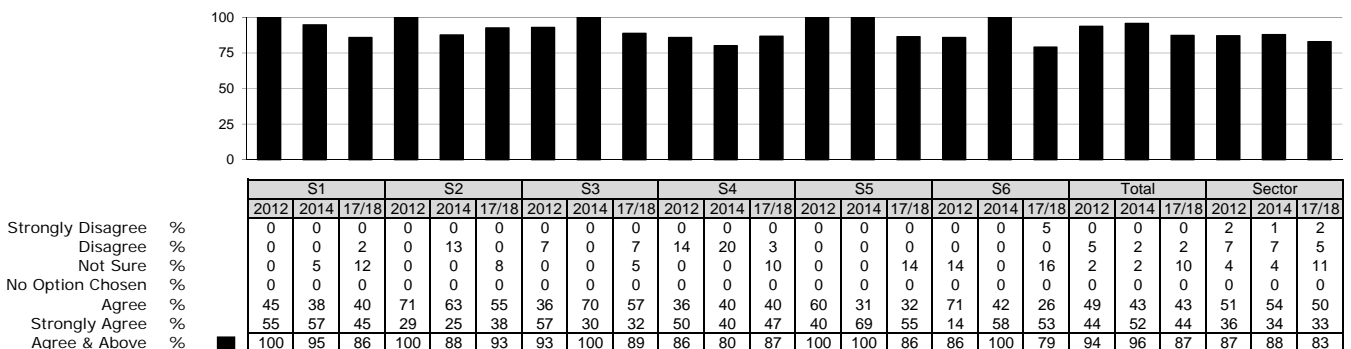
Q 1. My child feels safe and cared for at school.



Q 2. I feel staff know my child as an individual and supports them well.



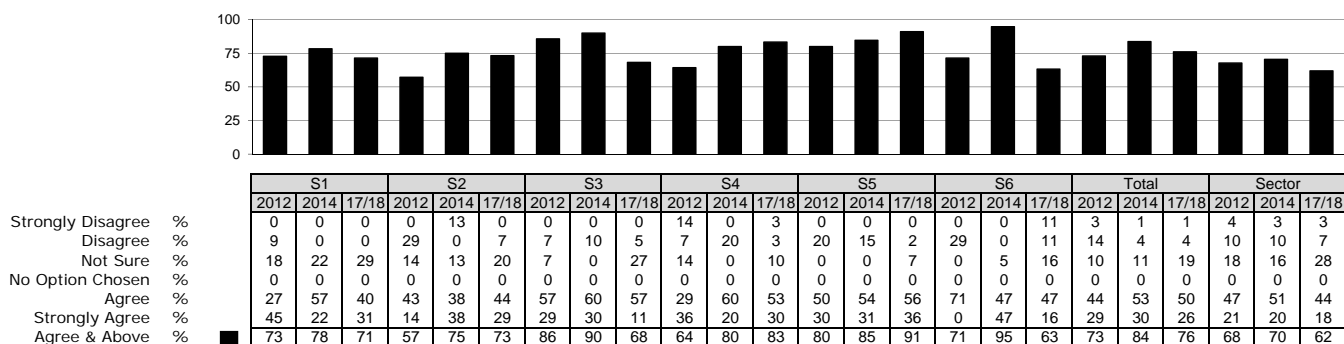
Q 3. I know who to contact if I am upset or worried about something that is affecting my child.



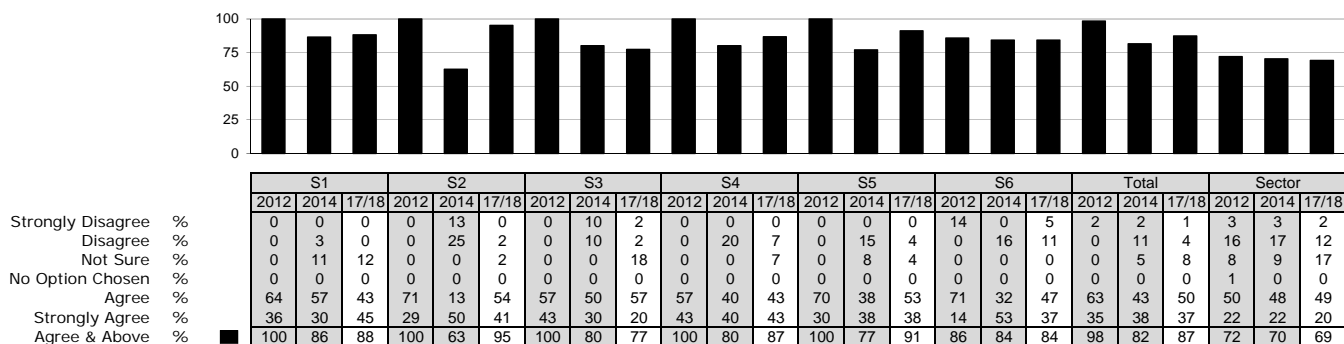

Q 4. If things go wrong, people in school are good at helping to sort things out.

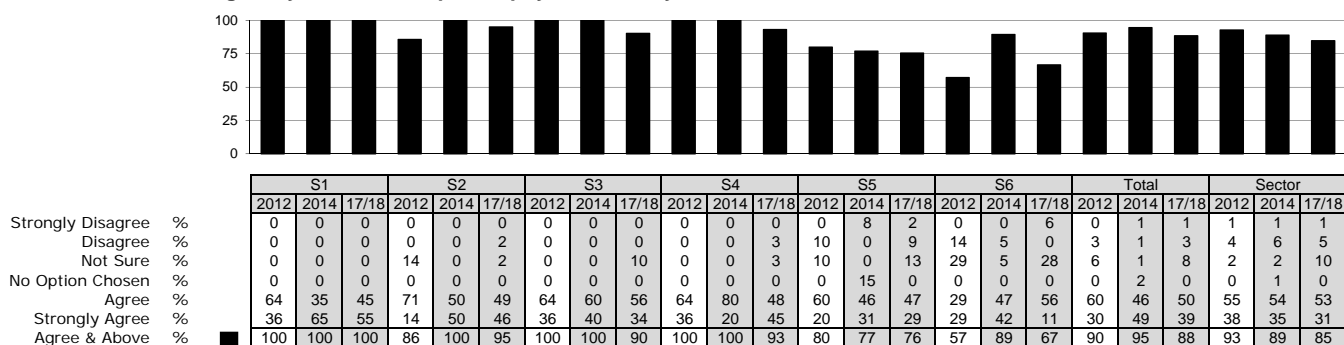


Q 5. My school shares information with me about how my child can stay safe when using technology to communicate with others (for example: internet, social networking, mobiles phones, email)

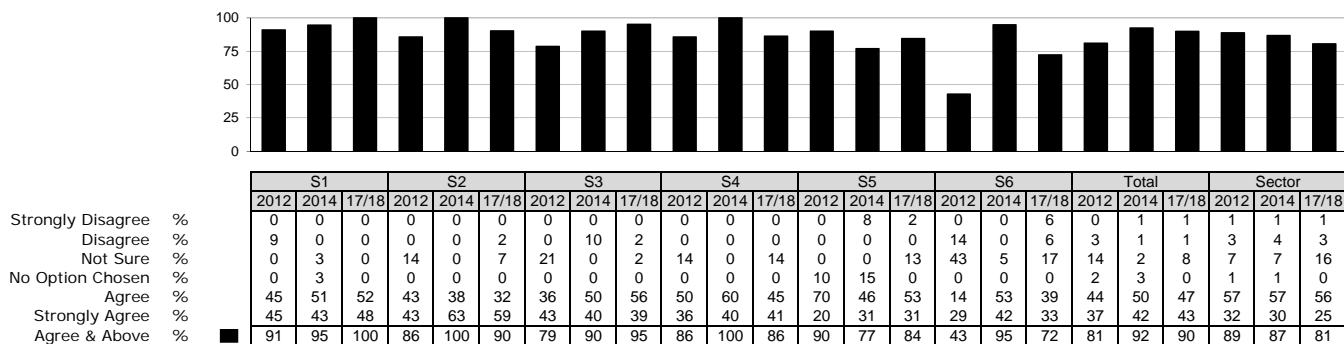


HEALTHY & ACTIVE

Q 6. The school encourages my child to take part in physical activity.



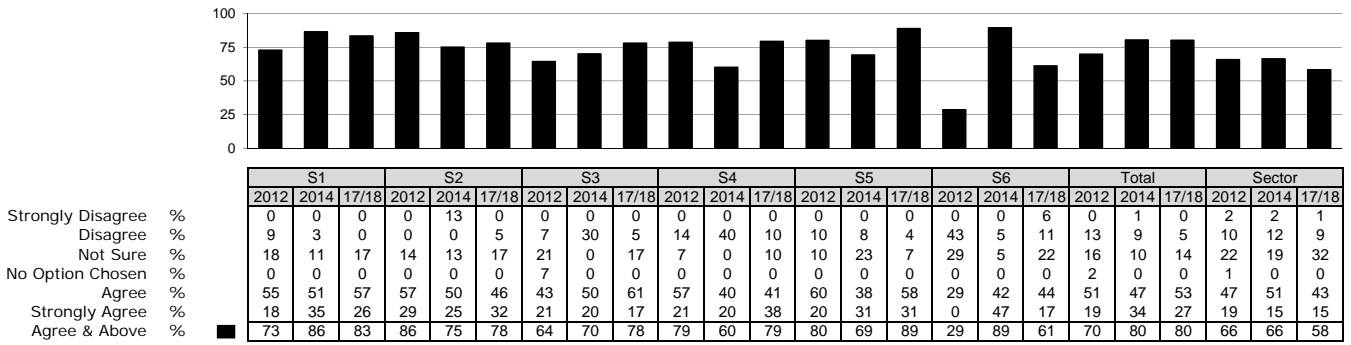

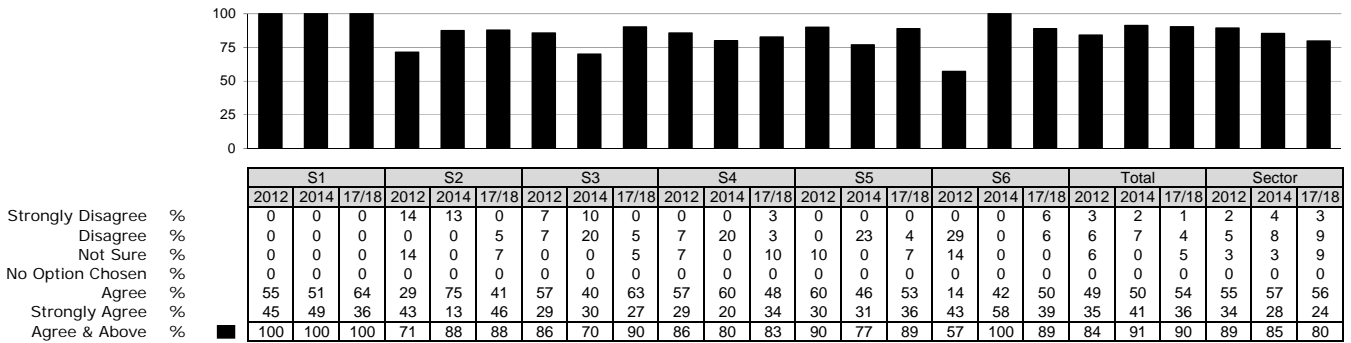

Q 8. The school helps my child to learn how to make friends and develop good relationships.

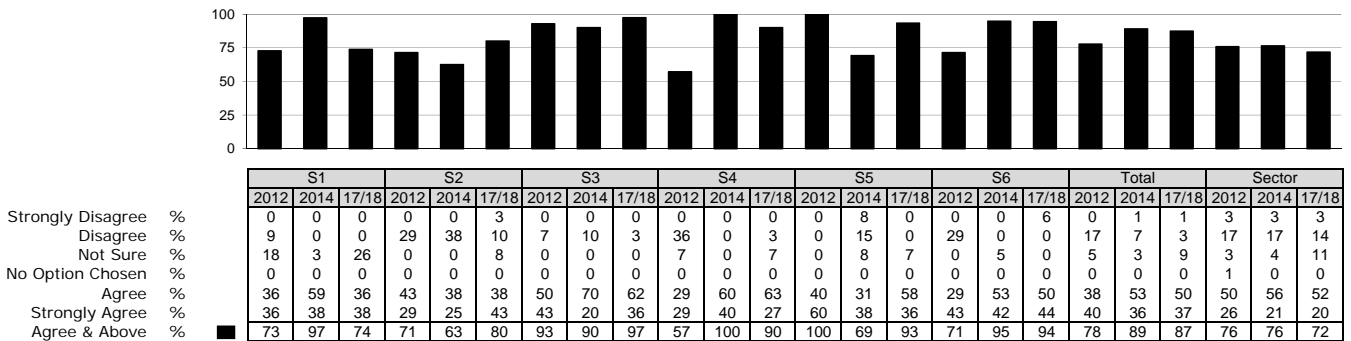


Q 9. I feel my child is happy at school.

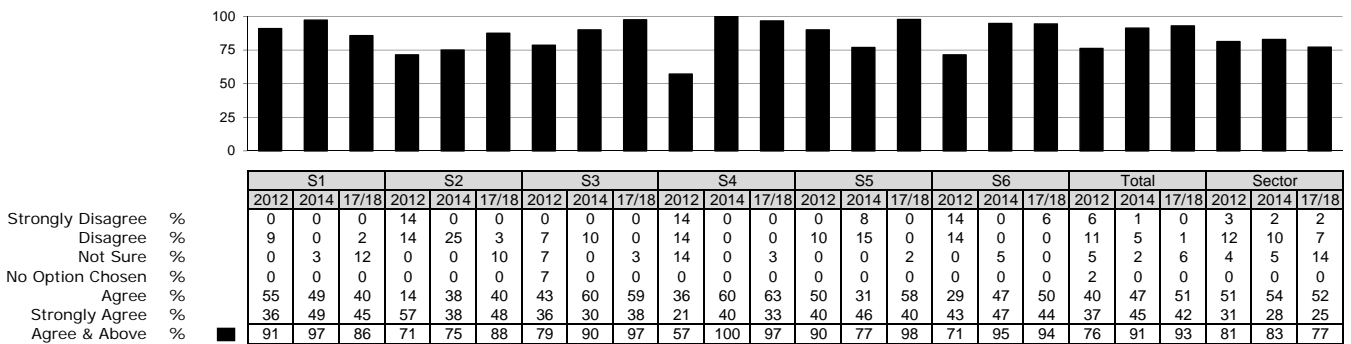

Q 11. I am happy with my child's progress in school.

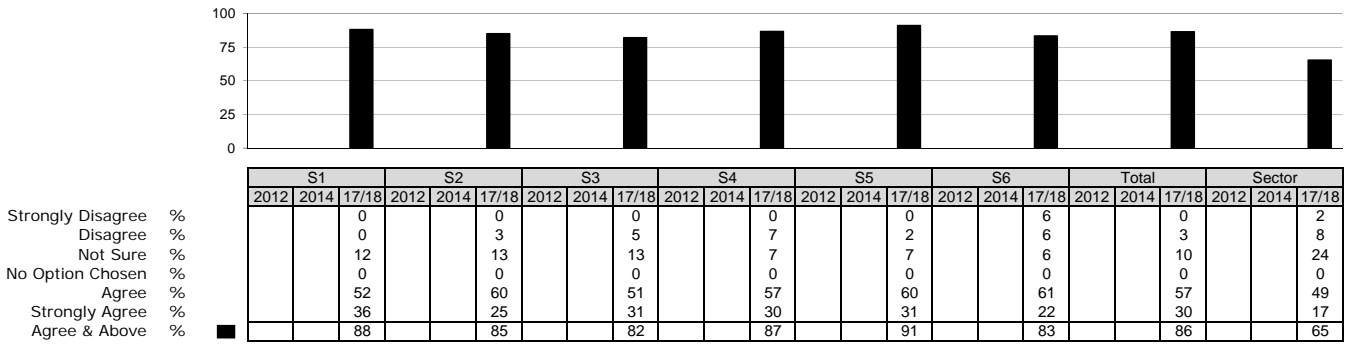

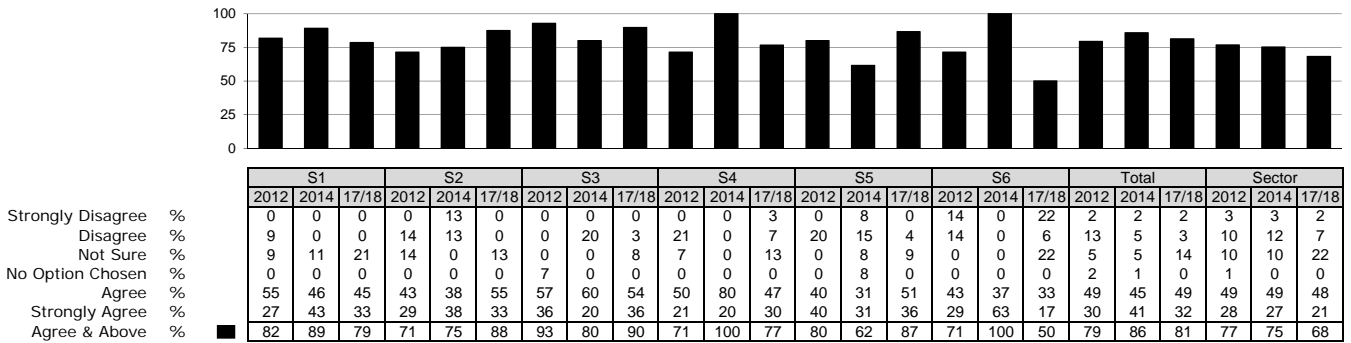

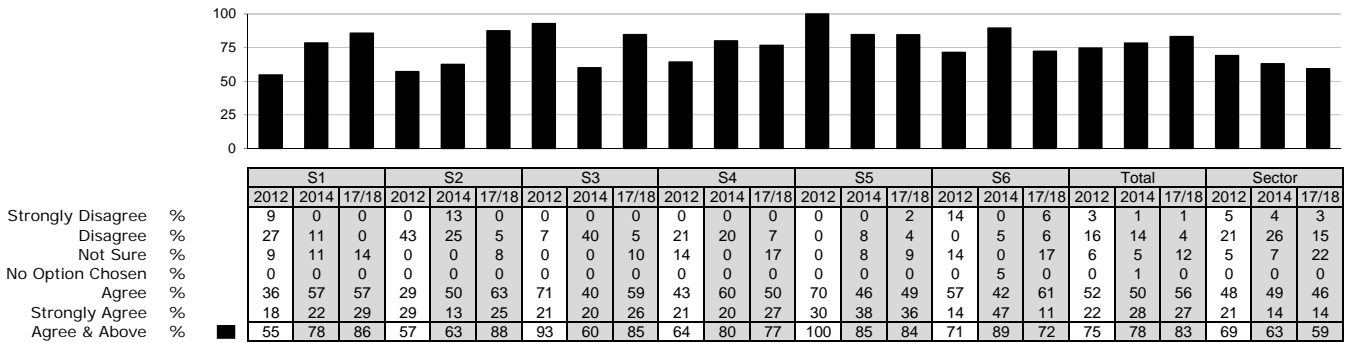
Q 12. My school is helping my child become more resilient and able to cope with challenges.



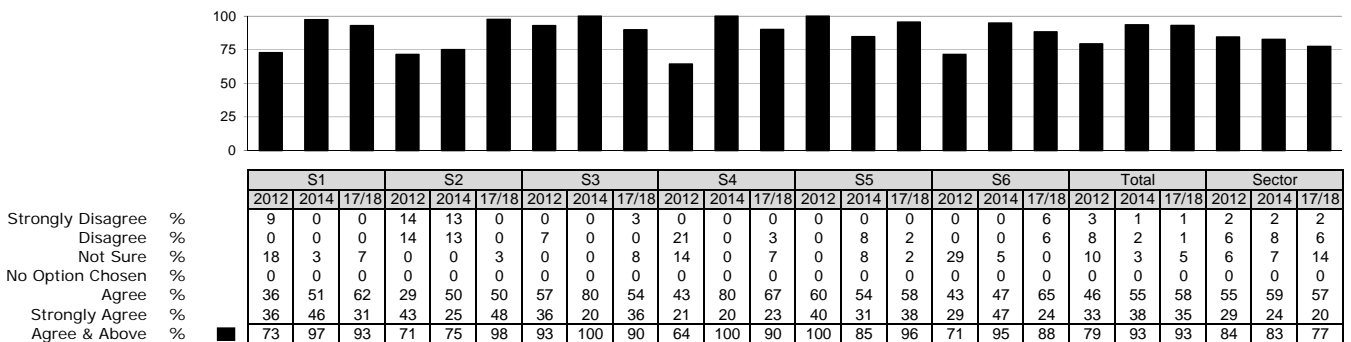
Q 13. The school recognises my child's achievements.

Q 15. My child is learning how to be more confident, independent and responsible at school.

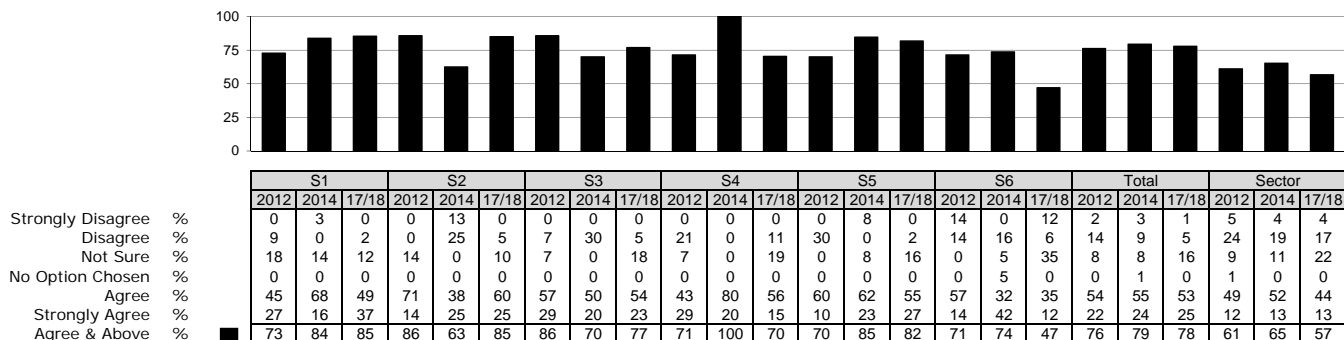

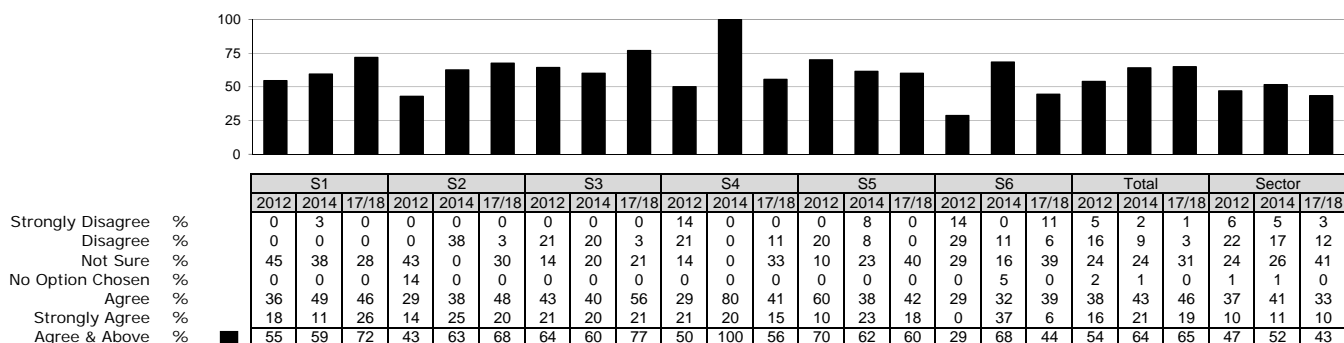

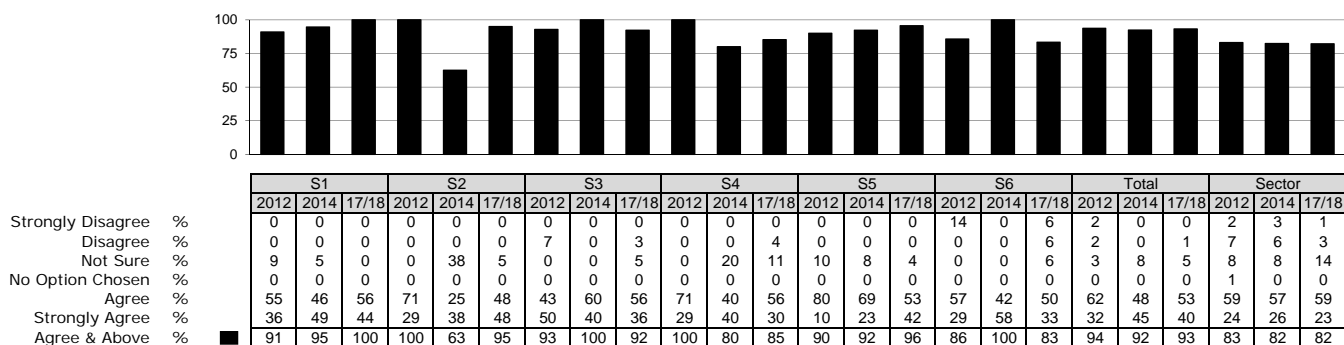
Q 16. The school asks for my views.



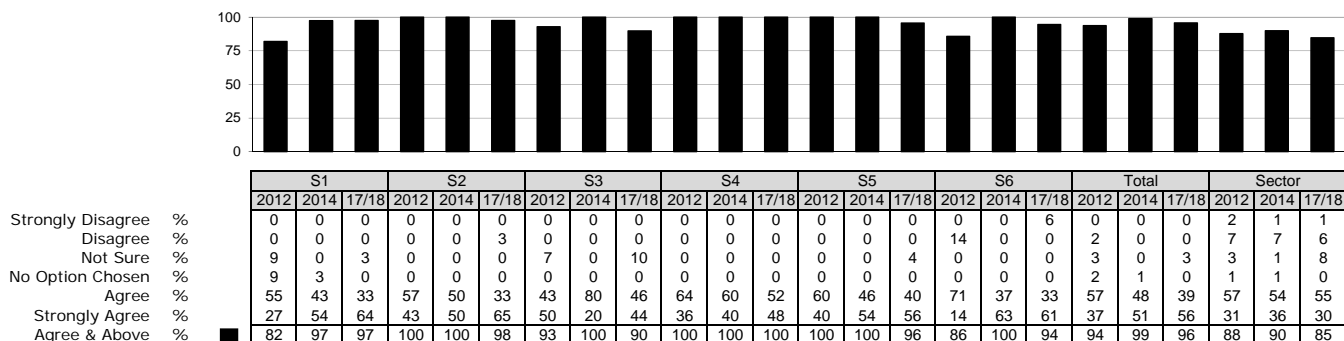
Q 17. The school takes my views into account.



Q 18. I feel welcome in school.



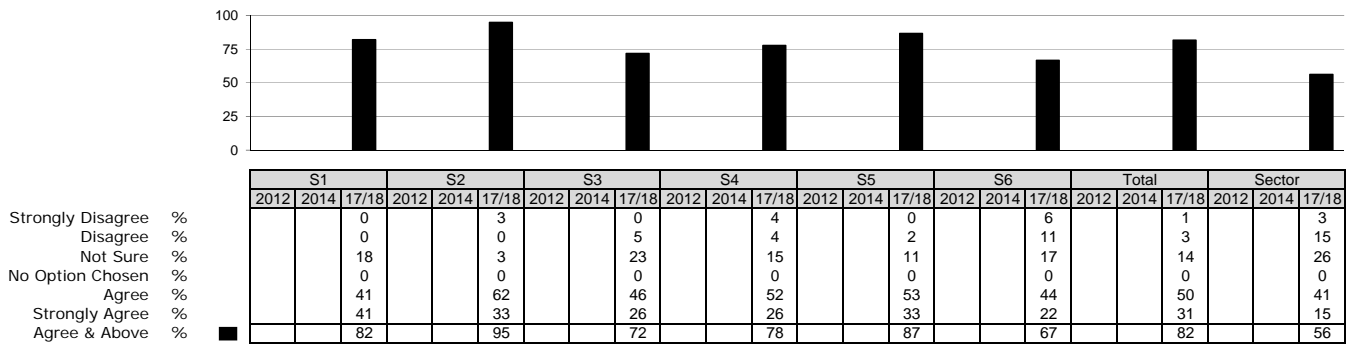
Q 19. I am kept well informed about the life of the school (eg: information letters, newsletters, e-mail, school websites etc)



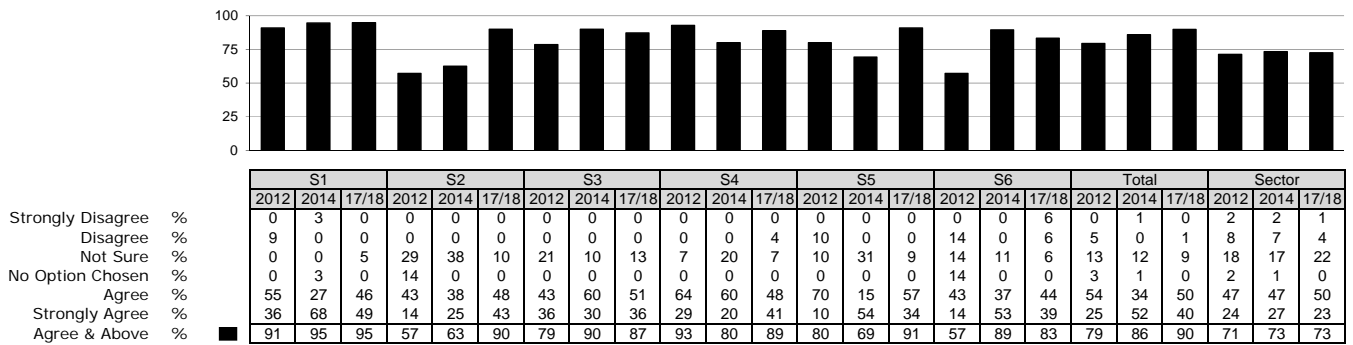
