Providing young women with a recognised SQA National Qualification at SCQF Level 5, while developing skills to support progression beyond school into further training or employment in the exciting energy sector

This year-long vocational qualification is sponsored by Shell, and offers young women aged from 14 to 17 years a unique insight into the oil and gas industry to enhance their employability skills alongside their school studies.

The programme includes a mix of classroom study, industry visits and workshops and runs in Rosyth, Dunfermline and Levenmouth. It provides a great stepping stone to Foundation Apprenticeships or full-time college courses.

These are just some of the skills that learners develop:

- Technical knowledge, skills and understanding related to engineering
- Awareness of health and safety issues
- Communication and teamwork skills
- An understanding and appreciation of the varied roles on offer within the sector

Learners also tell us that their confidence continues to grow as the course progresses!
