End of term letter June 2024

Welcome to the last letter / update of session 2023/24. I hope that you find the information contained in this letter useful and I hope that all young people and families have a safe, happy and enjoyable summer.

Highlights from the session

Another session has been and gone, but a lot of progress has been made here at KHS.

This year, we were re-accredited with our Gold Rights Respecting School Award, recognition for embedding Children's Rights across our school and community and commitment to ensuring these rights are at the centre of all we do.

We continue to see improvements in outcomes for young people with almost all leavers leaving KHS with level 4 Literacy and Numeracy, and most at level 5. We also succeeded with almost all leavers moving on to a positive, sustained destination, meeting our stretch target, surpassing the Fife average and closing the gap to the National average.

We have had significant progress in addressing social issues in school, reducing the number of incidents of reported bullying, ensuring that almost all young people feel safe in school, and improving attendance for a number of key target groups.

We had a successful consultation with all stakeholders about significant changes to our Curriculum and school day that will ensure we can continue with the improvements made over the past couple of sessions.

School Improvement Plan and Pupil Equity Fund update

Attached to this letter is a summary of our School Improvement Plan for session 2024/25. This is year 2 of a 3-year plan. We have set out 4 priorities for school improvement:

- All learners will benefit from developed leadership, high aspiration and renewed KHS Vision, Values and Aims
- Learners will benefit from a balanced and cohesive curriculum that leads to increased attainment for all, supporting continued improved Positive Destinations
- All learners will increase engagement, participation and leadership in learning, leading to an increase in confidence, motivation and achievement

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• Learners will benefit from universal, targeted and intensive supports, relevant to each learner and ensuring that we meet the needs of all
