Acceptable

- White shirt, polo shirt or blouse – (with collar)

- Plain black trousers, black jeans or knee length skirt
- Plain black jumper or cardigan (or alternative school jumper)
- Black footwear



Not Acceptable

- Sports leggings e.g Nike Pro leggings
- Denim (blue) jeans
- Track suits
- White or coloured shoes/trainers
- Hoodies or jumper with large logos
