Teenage vaccinations 2025

Essential immunisations for high school pupils in years 1 to 6 across Fife.

What vaccines are offered?

HPV vaccine (from year 1)

This vaccine helps protect against cancers caused by human papillomavirus (HPV). It's important for both girls and boys.

DTP and MenACWY (from year 3)

These vaccines protect against tetanus, diphtheria and polio, as well as meningitis strains A, C, W, and Y. They are quick and easy to administer and provide lifelong protection.
