<u>Acceptable</u>

· White shirt, polo shirt or blouse –

(with collar)

- · School tie visible at all times
- Plain black trousers, black jeans or knee length skirt
 - · Plain black jumper or cardigan
 - · Black footwear

Not Acceptable



- · Sheer leggings
- · Denim (blue) jeans
 - · Track suits
- · White or coloured shoes/trainers
- · Hoodies or jumper with large logos
- · Shorts (unless wearing them in PE)
 - · Jogging bottoms
