<p>Headteacher's update</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Two P7s will go to Waid after this term and the roll will fall by two - Outdoor learning and transition work continues to go well; Mrs Barker continuing to explore opportunities for all Kirkton pupils to mix more with peers at Lundin Mill - Outdoor learning slightly different this term as focusing on more work in class at present, although still planning trips to the library and elsewhere - Leavers' hoodies – school has funds to pay for this this year - 2/3/23 – author Justin Davies 'I Smell a Monster' coming to do some sessions with all pupils for World Book Day; plan for all the kids to dress up - 23/3/23 – learning partnership when Fife Council officer Sharon Smith will share the work being done with the wider community, pupils and parents - Ardroy – plan is still for p6s and p7s to go in 2023; Broomlee will also go ahead in 2023 and 2024 (possible alternative venue due to negative feedback on catering and some activity organisation) - NE Fife Local Improvement Forum is examining rural poverty – could offer support for Ardroy as needed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Mrs Barker to update PC once know the details to see who can attend that day to give feedback
