Our topic/theme for learning this term will be:		
Ancient Egyptians -Research and share information about some aspects of the daily life of the ancient Egyptians.		
Literacy:		
<p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>Use knowledge of sounds, letters and patterns to read words. Use contexts clues to read and understand texts. Skim and scan texts to find key information.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p><i>Genre:</i> Information - Create and share posters, fact files and presentations. Imaginative/Narrative - Create an historical fiction text and retell/create Egyptian myths.</p> <p><i>Grammar:</i> P1 Can show some control with making marks on e.g. paper and write first letter of name. P2 Begin to use phonics to try writing words. P2-7 Identify nouns and proper nouns. Locate words in a simple dictionary using the first letter. P4 Give further examples of e.g transport, animal nouns. Locate /sort words using first and second letter. P5-7 Become more confident in using a variety of contractions. Numeracy:		
<p>Number, Money and Measure</p> <p><u>Blue Group</u> Recite, read, write, order numbers 0-15/20/30. Use fingers to show numbers 0-10 OR Recall addition and subtraction facts to 6.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Shape, Position and Movement</p> <p>Recognises and describes common 2D and 3D shapes. Uses mathematical language to describe 2D and 3D shapes, identifies symmetry and can recognise and create tiling patterns.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Information Handling</p> <p>Not covered this term</p>

<p><u>Green Group</u> Recite, read, write, order numbers 0-999. Quickly recall addition facts to 15 and subtraction facts to 10.</p> <p><u>Red Group</u> Recite, read, write, order, count in 10s/100s, find halfway numbers using 4-digit numbers. Calculate by splitting numbers into smaller parts or by jumping in tens.</p> <p><u>Yellow Group</u> Identify, sequence, say numbers before and after 5/6- digit numbers. Understand numbers to one decimal place. Calculate by splitting numbers into smaller parts or by jumping in tens.</p>	<p>Calculates the perimeter, area and volume of shapes.</p>	
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Health and Wellbeing: (Pupils will not cover all 7 wellbeing indicators every term but will experience them all over the course of the year)

SAFE	Demonstrate different ways of moving body safely, creatively and with control. Assess risk and demonstrate safety when working and sharing space with others - multi-skills. The pupils will learn more about assessing risk during their weekly outdoor learning sessions.
