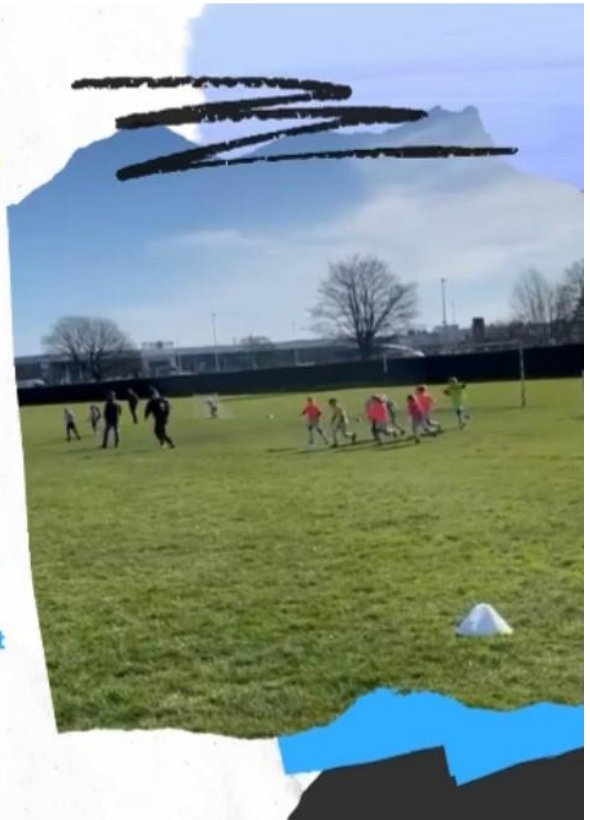
Are looking for budding footballers to join our club!

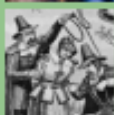

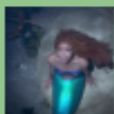
