Activities and Festive Events – Information For Parents:

- **Wednesday 10th December** PM Our P6 and P7 pupils will receive their Transforming Learning iPad. Initially these will be kept in school and we will let parents know when we intend to start sending them home.

- Saturday 13th December Parent Council Christmas Fair 1.30-3pm
- Monday 15th December AM All pupils will be visiting Lawhead for a workshop called Bubble Gum and Fluff. The workshop will be delivered by a team of local volunteers, accredited by Scripture Union Scotland and led by the local K2 worker. The workshop will include a range of activities for the pupils to engage in including art, drama and science all related to the bible stories of the first Christmas. They will focus on the 'bubble gum' heart of the story and the 'fluff' of the extra parts connected to Christmas. This links to the second level Curriculum for Excellence experiences and outcomes for Religious and Moral Education. Further information on the outcomes covered can be provided if any parents would like this information. If you have any questions regarding your child's participation in the workshop please do not hesitate to get in touch and a member of staff would be happy to discuss this with you. Staff will drive the pupils to/from Lawhead and they will be back for lunch as normal.

Wild Oaks - New Outdoor Learning Group:

I am delighted to let you know about a new **outdoor learning group – Wild Oaks** – running at **St Andrews Botanic Garden**, and to invite families to join us.

Wild Oaks is aimed at pre-schoolers and primary school flexi-Friday families who would like to spend regular, meaningful time outdoors together. Sessions take place every Friday from 10:30am – 12:00pm and are designed to be inclusive, child-led and nature-focused, with a strong emphasis on building confidence and community.

Through Wild Oaks, children will have the opportunity to:

- Develop leadership and mentoring skills, with older children gently supporting younger ones
- Learn about nature and biodiversity, exploring the Garden's woodland, ponds and meadows
- Build teamwork and communication skills through group collaboration, play and shared tasks
- Spend unhurried time outside with local families, helping foster friendship, resilience and wellbeing

During sessions we:

- Explore different areas of the Garden in all weathers
- Take part in seasonal nature and conservation activities
- Enjoy creative play, storytelling and nature-based crafts
- Practice **mindful moments outdoors**, helping children connect calmly with nature
