## LINO PRINTING WORKSHOP

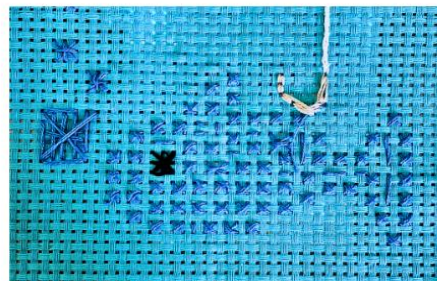
