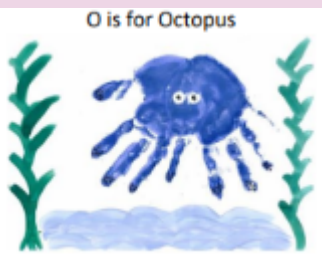
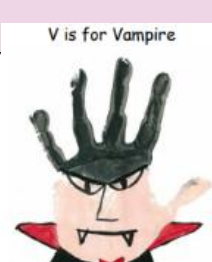
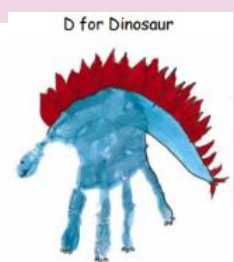

The children can either write it on a piece of paper or make a PowerPoint and they will present it at the end of term 1.
	Junk Model Spacecraft: Construct a replica of the International Space Station, a Mars rover, or a rocket ship using cardboard boxes and foil. Or Galaxy in a Jar: Layer cotton balls, glitter, and colored water inside a clean jar to create a swirling miniature nebula	Bring your creation into school in Term 2.
