The parentsportal.scot booking system for the forthcoming parent/teacher appointments will **go live on Monday 28 August, 2023 at 4.00pm**. You will receive a system notification confirming this* from 4.00pm onwards as each class is set to 'live'. If accessing parentsportal.scot via the browser, you will receive an email. If you are accessing parentsportal.scot via the app, you will receive an in app system notification.

In advance of booking, please take a few minutes to familiarise yourself with the process for booking appointments by watching the YouTube video below. The easiest way to **book the appointment** is via the notification bell within parentsportal.scot Please note that once the deadline for booking has passed you will no longer be able to book/amend online. The deadline for booking is Friday 8 September, 2023. We would appreciate it if you can book your appointment at your earliest convenience. Only parents/carers registered in parentsportal.scot can use this facility.
