Put them in order of your choice eg size, favourite, oldest etc. Draw or take a picture of them. Label them 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc.</p> <p>Extension: Also write order in words - first, second third etc.</p>	<p>Bring drawings in to share or post pictures on our class Team page.</p>
Topic	<p>LI: I people who help us in our community</p> <p>SC: create a poster with a drawing / image and some information about someone in our community who helps us</p>	<p>Choose a person in our community who helps us.
