Our topic/theme for learning this term will be:

People Who Help Us

Literacy:

Reading

P1 will begin to work through our phonics scheme. You will find the letters we are working on this term in the homework grid. We will begin to blend the sounds together to read simple cvc words.

Writing

Genre: Personal writing

This term we will be 'writing' about ourselves and our families through drawing and sharing stories.

Grammar: We are learning that print has meaning. We will work on our pencil grip and the correct formation of letters, including our names.

Listening and Talking

As a class, we are practising listening to others and waiting our turn to talk.

We will practise hearing and saying our sounds of the week.

Numeracy:

Number, Money and Measure

Our main numeracy focus for this term will be number recognition and place value. We will read, write, order and count numbers and think about how they can be broken into chunks e.g 5 can be 2+3.

Shape, Position and Movement

Not covered this term.

This term we will find ways to group and sort a variety of objects.

Social Subjects:	This term we will think about the different jobs people do in our community. We will consider the ways people help us and the services shops provide.	
Sciences:	During our outdoor learning time, we will explore living things around us and consider how they depend on each other.
