Next Week: Ecoutez (listen) and Repetez (repeat)

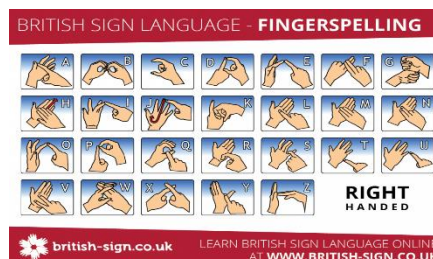
