

Water During The School Day:

When we return to school after the October break we will have a refreshed focus on the importance of good hydration during the school day. All children will be reminded to take a drink of water at transition points during the school day – when they come in at 9am, before morning break, after morning break, at lunch and after lunch.

In order to support with good hydration, we would ask that all parents ensure that their child arrives at school with a clean, filled water bottle at the start of each day. Pupils have access to the water fountain during the day if their bottle needs to be filled.

Regular water intake throughout the school day can also help with good bladder and bowel health – parents may find this website useful - Home - ERIC. Good hydration also helps with focus and concentration.

A handy tip to help encourage your child to drink regularly throughout the day is to mark your child's water bottle with lines and times – why don't you give it a try?
