
Message from the School Office:

parentsportal.scot - Notice Board

Lawhead's subscription with the Connectus 'School App for Parents' has now expired and is therefore no longer accessible. As noted in August's newsletter, going forward, we will be fully utilising parentsportal.scot including to share news and relevant documents. If you have yet to download the parentsportal.scot app, please do so as it is much better than accessing it via a browser, it is easy to use and will simplify many tasks for you.

As a reminder, parentsportal.scot allows you to report pupil absences, review your child's attendance, review the school calendar, complete the 'Annual Data Check' and we will now use the 'Notice Board' section within 'Services' to upload news/information and relevant communications, starting today with the weekly Newsletter.

When a Notice is posted, you will receive an email/app notification and then by navigating to the 'Notice Board' within 'Services' - see below, you will be able to access the notice.
