Choose or find your own recipe to prepare a snack or meal. It can be any recipe of your choice but there are some examples in the link below.</p> <p>Easy recipes for kids - BBC Food</p> <p>The most likely units of measurement will be kg/g and l/ml.</p> <p>*REMEMBER THAT IF YOU ARE USING AN OVEN OR HOT PAN/POT GET HELP FROM AN ADULT AT HOME.</p> <p>Here is a link to several recipes, like pancakes, flatbreads, frittata.</p> <p>You could also make something like a smoothie (does not involve an oven).</p> <p>Share your recipe with the measurements in the Measuring Recipe Assignment.</p>	<p>You can share your recipe or even take pictures of your creations</p> <p>Extension: can you convert any of your measurements from decimal to imperial?</p>
<p>Literacy</p>	<p>L.I. to write for different purposes and readers, I can describe and share my experiences, expressing what they made me think about and how they made me feel.</p>	<p>Write a poem to describe your time at Lawhead OR Write a description of some of your favourite memories at Lawhead (200 word maximum)</p> <p>Go to the assignment Personal Writing to get the full instructions and ideas for your poem/personal writing piece.</p> <p>This task will be used in preparation for the Leavers' Assembly.</p> <p>Your finished piece of writing should be submitted by MONDAY 17TH JUNE to give time to practice using some of them at the assembly.</p>	<p>We will help plan this in class by looking at examples and helping you plan ideas.</p> <p>Writing should be submitted in the assignment page or handed in as a hard copy in class.</p> <p>Good luck!</p>
