



THE ST ANDREWS GOLF CLUB'S BOYS' GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP TUESDAY 4TH JUNE 2024

The stroke play sections of the above competition will be played over the Eden and Strathtyrum Courses on Tuesday the 4th of June 2024 from 4:00 pm.

The competition is limited to boys, and residents in, or at school in St. Andrews who will be 10 years old by the day of the competition and who are not past their 16th birthday on the day of the competition.

Boys aged 10, 11 and 12 will play 9 holes over the Strathtyrum course while boys aged 13, 14, and 15 years will play 18 holes over the Eden course.

There are 3 trophies: -

- The St Andrews Boy's Medal for the Senior winner, 13-15 years old.
- The Forester's Medal for the best score by a boy, 10-12 years old.
- · The James Marr Trophy to the Junior winner, under 10 years old.

Several prizes will be awarded and every boy taking part will receive a golf ball when teeing off on the first tee.

All entrants should report to the official in charge at the Eden Course Starter's Box from 3:45 p.m. onwards and ensure that they report at least 15 minutes before their scheduled tee-off times.
