Parking Concerns:

Parking around the school grounds at morning drop off and pick up time is an ongoing problem and concern that we ask all parents to take seriously. The turning circle must be kept clear at ALL times. The Cosmos staff are unable to collect children in the minibus as a number of parents continue to park in an inconsiderate and illegal manner. The car park is for school staff only. Staff are unable to park because parents are using these spaces and on occasion have been late as a result. We need all parents who drive to drop off/collect their child to park further away from the school entrance to reduce the dangerous level on congestion.
