Term 1 and 2: August - December 2024

Our topic/theme for learning this term will be:			
Term 1: St. Andrews Term 2: Toys			
Literacy:			
<p>This session we will work on our phonics skills, each week we will learn 2 new sounds. Reading books will be sent home after the children are confidently blending with the first set of sounds. For most, this will be after the October break.</p> <p>A homework jotter will be shared so you can help your child to learn each sound at home.</p> <p>In term 1 we focus on enjoyment and choice, engaging with books and stories being shared and choosing their own books in the school library. In term 2 we will focus on retelling stories and using their knowledge of letter sounds and patterns to read words.</p>	Writing		Listening and Talking
	<p>In term 1 we will focus on correct pencil grip and correct formation of our own name. We will begin to write the letters we have learned each week. We will write about ourselves, our families and our favourite things using pictures.</p> <p>In term 2 we will begin to attempt to write words, we will continue to work on correct letter formation and an understanding that text goes from the left to right. We will explore sentences and understand that a sentence conveys meaning.</p> <p>We will use pictures and some words to tell our own stories.</p>		<p>In term 1 our focus will be listening to others and talking turns to talk.</p> <p>In term 2 we will focus on sharing our ideas to a small group or the class.</p>
