You will receive a system notification confirming this from 4.00pm onwards on Monday as each class is set to 'live'. If accessing parentsportal.scot via the browser, you will receive an email notification; if you are accessing parentsportal.scot via the app (best experience), you will also receive an in-app system notification.


In advance of booking, please take a few minutes to familiarise yourself with the process for booking appointments by watching the YouTube video link below (video tutorial only available for the browser process).

The easiest way to book the appointment is via the notification bell within parentsportal.scot

The deadline for booking appointments is **Thursday 6 March**, **2024**. We would appreciate it if you can book your appointment(s) at your earliest convenience, particularly if your availability is limited, to ensure that you secure the date/time you need. Please note that once the deadline for booking has passed you will no longer be able to book/amend the appointment online.


Please also note that only parents/carers registered in parentsportal.scot can use this facility and where both the main and secondary contacts are registered, the notification will be sent to the <u>main contact</u>. Where only the secondary contact is registered, they will receive the notification.

For parents/carers who are <u>using the app</u>, please see the below screenshot to ensure the correct service is chosen or access 'Notifications' from the app.


Via the browser, How to book a slot at parents night on parentsportal.scot - YouTube

Dear Parents and Carers,



Apply for your child's place in primary one today

All parents/carers of any child eligible to start primary one in August 2025 should submit an enrolment application online at fife.gov.uk/applyforaschoolplace

This straightforward system allows parents/carers to use the step-by-step form from a smart phone, computer or tablet at any time of the day.

You will also be able to upload verification documents too.

These documents include:

- birth certificate of child
- o council tax notification letter
- evidence of current address
 e.g. gas or electric bill,
 driving licence or benefits letter.

Apply before 9am on 17th March 2025
