The Big Walk and Wheel, 24 March - 4 April

This is a week to celebrate cycling, scooting and walking to school. On each day, schools compete to see who can get the highest percentage of their pupils walking, scooting or cycling to school. It's a chance for the school to win prizes!

<u>But</u> our pupils need support from all parents/carers. Children and parents walking in and out of school should be able to walk safely, where they can see and be seen. The area outside our school gates is busy, and inconsiderate driving and parking is potentially placing children in danger. No-one wants to see one of our pupils hit by a car.

Improving parking at the school gates

We have created a Parking Pledge. We ask parents and carers to follow these guidelines to give our pupils a safer environment outside our school gates.



Walk, wheel and scoot (or take the walking bus)

Park and stride (park further away, walk the last 100m)

Drive and manoeuvre with care

Park considerately and safely



Don't idle your engine while parking

Don't park in the turning circle, or the staff car park

Don't park: - on double yellow lines

- within 10m of a junction

- on 'Keep Clear' markings

- on pavements or block driveways

We know that not everyone can walk all the way to school every day. But for those that need to drive some of the way, please consider *Park & Stride*.







