Tempest Photographer – Monday 12th May:

Tempest photographers will be in school all day on Monday 12th May to take individual and sibling photographs for our nursery and P1-7 pupils. Due to the very tight schedule for the day there will not be the opportunity for younger or older siblings who do not attend Lawhead Primary School or Nursery to be included in these pictures. This is the only day that the photographer will be in school so we will be unable to offer the opportunity for a catch-up session if your child is absent or on holiday on this date. You will be provided with previews and information on how to order – this will come home with your child on 12th May. There is no obligation to purchase any photos.

Warmer Weather:

Now that the sunnier weather is on its way parents should consider applying sunscreen before school or providing their child with sunscreen to keep in their bag. Please note that school staff are not permitted to apply sunscreen for children. Pupils should bring a filled water bottle to school each day and this can be refilled at the water fountain as required. You may also want to pop a sunhat or cap in your child's bag.

As per our uniform expectations (sent out today with the newsletter) pupils are permitted to wear tailored shorts but lycra/aerobic style shorts are not school uniform and should only be worn for PE.
