Last week relevant parents received a letter from Angela Logue our Head of Service providing information about this exciting initiative. This was then followed by this link being sent to P5 and P6 parents - <u>Transforming Learning - Roll out of 1:1 Devices - Lawhead Primary School (Page 1 of 2)</u>. If you have not yet completed this form please can you do so as the deadline has now passed.

Lawhead pupils are scheduled to receive their 1:1 device in December. Prior to this there will be workshops, additional information and training for pupils, staff and parents to ensure everyone will be well supported during this journey. Mrs. Bain will be happy to meet with parents/carers next session as we get closer to the roll out to discuss any specific concerns that parents may have. Please ensure you have looked carefully at the FAQs and other information available on the Transforming Learning website - Vision — Transforming Learning in Fife. This will be updated regularly.

This initiative has been very well planned and will be well supported in the years to come. Devices do not teach children, teachers teach children and having access to a personal device will enhance pedagogy as well as unlocking greater opportunities for creativity, accessibility and equity. We are very excited to get started on our Transforming Learning journey.

House Challenges – Friday 20th June – 1.45pm:

On Friday afternoon parents and carers are welcome to join us to spectate and cheer on our houses during our annual house challenge afternoon. All pupils will be split into mixed stage groups consisting of members of their house. They will then rotate round a series of challenges and earn points for their house for each challenge completed. Parents can access the school grounds after 1.25pm when the bell goes at the end of lunch and the children are brought inside. The spectator area will be marked off with cones. Pupils will be dismissed at 3.05pm as normal.



Pupils can come to school dressed in their sports wear and are encouraged to wear their house colour. If pupils still have their banners from sports day they can bring these in as well. The weather forecast is looking good so please ensure your child has a filled water bottle and has applied sunscreen. You may also want to provide a sun hat or cap.


