Milk Fund Term 1 2025-26

The milk fund is now open for the provision of school pupil milk during Term 1, 2025-26; the cost for Term 1 is £9.50. The fund will remain open over the Summer break and will close at midnight on <u>Sunday 24 August</u>. Please ensure that you make a payment within this timescale if you would like your child to have milk in Term 1.

Pupils will start their milk provision on Wednesday 20 August for payments made by **midnight on Sunday 17 August**. Due to supplier order deadlines, for any payment made from Monday 18 and Sunday 24 August, pupils will start their milk provision within two working days of payment.

Please note, for any families that have a new Primary 1 child starting next term, iPayimpact information and registration instructions will be sent home in the first week of school once your Primary 1 child has been formally enrolled; you will then be able to order and pay for their milk, if required.


