### School - Pupil milk:

The milk fund is open for the provision of school pupil milk during Term 1, 2025-26; the cost for Term 1 is £9.50. The fund will close at midnight on <u>Sunday 24 August</u>. Please ensure that you make a payment within this timescale if you would like your child to have milk in Term 1.

#### Parking:


This is a reminder to always keep the turning circle clear. Please park considerately around the school grounds. We will report unsafe parking to the police with a note of registration numbers and photo evidence.
