Reminders For Families:

- All children need a change of indoor shoes in school to wear in class and outdoor footwear for the playground. Pupils without a change of shoes won't be allowed to play on the grass as it gets muddier in the winter months.
- Pupils should always have PE kit in school so they can safely join in with lessons. Crocs and sliders are not appropriate footwear for PE lessons. Pupils with hair longer than shoulder length need to tie their hair back and jewellery needs to be removed.
- We don't allow lolly pops as a snack or packed lunch treat. This is to avoid potential accidents when pupils are busy running around and playing.
