PE Day Reminder and Uniform Expectations:

Please note there have been some changes to PE days due to timetable changes.

P1/2 – Miss Morrow and Miss Hippiisley	Tuesday (inside) and Friday (outside)
P2 – Mrs Allan	Monday (outside), Tuesday (currently working with football coach so can be outdoors) and Wednesday (indoors)
P3 – Mr Greenall	Monday (indoors) and Thursday (outside)
P3/4 – Mrs Simpson and Miss Johnston	Wednesday (outside) and Thursday (inside)
P4/5 – Mrs Currie	Tuesday (indoors) and Friday (outside)
P5/6 – Mr Munro	Monday (indoors) and Tuesday (outside)
P6 – Miss Garty	Tuesday (outside) and Friday (inside)
P7 – Miss Forsyth	Monday (outside) and Friday (inside)

It is very important that pupils have appropriate clothing and footwear in order to safely take part in their PE lessons. Parents may wish to send kit in to school on a Monday and leave it in school all week. Pupils can then take it home on a Friday to be washed if required.

Crocs and sliders are not appropriate footwear for any PE lessons. Wearing footwear of this type for PE can lead to injury. Pupils will be asked to do indoor PE in bare feet if they don't have suitable footwear to avoid slips and falls or alternative footwear will be provided from available stock in school.

All jewellery and watches must be removed before the start of a lesson. This is the responsibility of the learner so please make sure they can remove their earrings or provide micro pore tape to cover earrings if they can't be removed.
