

It is now time to complete the 'Annual Data Check' for your child/ren. For parents/carers of school pupils 'Main contacts' only will receive a system notification in parentsportal.scot today to carry out the 'Annual Data Check' within the parentsportal.scot system. Please take a few minutes to access this, update the record(s), if applicable, and **submit** the 'Annual Data Check' (even if there are no changes in the information we hold), by Friday 6 February 2026.

For school pupils where only the 'Secondary Contact' is registered and linked in parentsportal.scot only the 'Main Contact' can carry out the specific 'Annual Data Check' task, however, you can still update your own details within parentsportal.scot.

Fife Council Nursery between

- If your child does not currently attend nursery (academic year 2025-26) or
- if your child has a 2-year-old placement or
- if you are looking to change your child's current placement type you must complete an application form online at www.fife.gov.uk/elcplaces between 15th December 2025 and 31st January 2026.



You will be able to apply for a funded early learning and childcare place at your preferred private nursery, playgroup or childminder, if they are in partnership with Fife Council. Applications should be made directly to these individual establishments and services. .

PROCEDURES

Our online enrolment system for pupils due to start primary one in August 2026 is now open for applications.

All parents/carers of any child eligible to start primary one in August 2026 should submit an enrolment application online at www.fife.gov.uk/applyforaschoolplace.

This straightforward system allows parents/carers to use the step-by-step form from a smart phone, personal computer or tablet. The system is available 24 hours a day.

You will also be able to upload verification documents via the system too.

These documents include:

- birth certificate of child
- council tax notification letter
- evidence of current address e.g. gas or electric bill, driving licence or benefits letter.

Applications close at midnight on 15th March 2026.
