

Please note that once the deadline for booking has passed you will no longer be able to book/amend the appointment online.

Please also note that only parents/carers registered in parentsportal.scot can use this facility **and where both the main and secondary contacts are registered, the notification will be sent to the main contact**. Where only the secondary contact is registered, they will receive the notification.

For parents/carers who are using the app, please see the below screenshot to ensure the correct service is chosen or access 'Notifications' from the app.


