

The easiest way to **book the appointment** is via the notification bell within parentsportal.scot


The deadline for booking appointments is **Friday 6 March**. We would appreciate it if you can book your appointment(s) at your earliest convenience, particularly if your availability is limited, to ensure that you secure the date/time you need. Please note that once the deadline for booking has passed you will no longer be able to book/amend the appointment online.

Please also note that only parents/carers registered in parentsportal.scot can use this facility **and where both the main and secondary contacts are registered, the notification will be sent to the main contact**. Where only the secondary contact is registered, they will receive the notification.

For parents/carers who are using the app, please see the below screenshot to ensure the correct service is chosen or access 'Notifications' from the app.



In browser, please note the parentsportal.scot dashboard screenshot below which confirms the 'tile' that you should utilise if you wish to review your booking/amend your booking.


Please choose the **'Parents' Night for Primary School'** tile and NOT the 'Parents Booking' tile.
