House Challenges – Monday 29th June – 1.45pm:

On Monday afternoon parents and carers are welcome to join us to spectate and cheer on our houses during our annual house challenge afternoon. (Rearranged following bad weather of Friday 26/6). All pupils will be split into mixed stage groups consisting of members of their house. They will then rotate round a series of challenges and earn points for their house for each challenge completed. Parents can access the school grounds after 1.25pm when the bell goes at the end of lunch and the children are brought inside. The spectator area will be marked off with cones. Pupils will be dismissed at 3.05pm as normal.



Pupils can come to school dressed in their sportswear and are encouraged to wear their house colour. If pupils still have their banners from sports day, they can bring these in as well. The weather forecast is looking good so please ensure your child has a filled water bottle and has applied sunscreen. You may also want to provide a sun hat or cap. A fleece or jumper would be good just in case!

Please remember we are a phone free school. Please can phones be left at home or in the car and if you do need to have it on your person please put it on silent and keep it in your bag or pocket. Photographing or filming is not allowed.

Please park considerately, if possible park further away and walk to the school. The turning circle must be kept clear and no one should be parked on the double yellow lines or zigzag lines.

Milk Fund for Term 1 - 2026-27

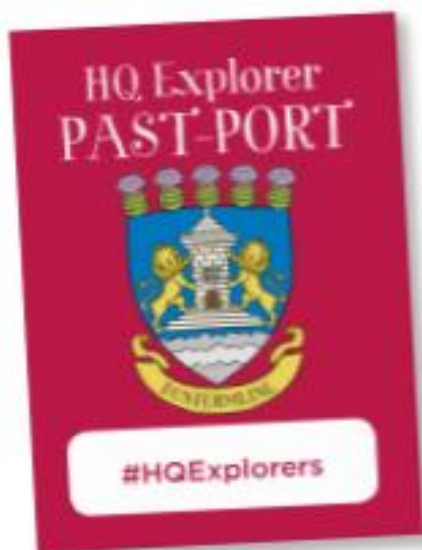
