School Meals:

Nursery and School Menus

Nursery and Primary School menus for 2026/27 are attached. All menu information will be available to view on [School meals | Fife Council](#) from Friday 14th August 2026.

For our new Lawhead Primary School families, once your child has been enrolled on Wednesday 19 August, the School Office will send out registration information for the iPayimpact system (iPay) on Thursday 20 August. Once registered in iPayimpact you will be able to book school meals for your school child at home for at least three weeks in advance. If choices are not made from home a meal choice will be made with your child in class, at registration.

Nursery children, with parents support if appropriate, will choose daily meal choices in Nursery at drop-off, as we do not use iPay at the Nursery stage.

Specific Dietary Requirements

If your child needs a specific diet due to medical, religious, or cultural reasons, requests for specific dietary requirements should be submitted through Fife Council's new online system. Please note that for existing pupils with a current adjusted menu in place, you should submit a new request for the 2026/27 session.

Milk Fund for Term 1 - 2026-27 - school only

The milk fund is open for the provision of school pupil milk during Term 1, 2026-27; the cost for Term 1 is £10.64 (28p per 189ml carton). The 'Milk Fund Term 1 2026-27' iPay fund will remain open over the summer break and will close at midnight on **Friday 21 August**. Please ensure that you make a payment within this timescale if you would like your child to have milk in Term 1. Pupils will start their milk provision on Wednesday 19 August for payments made by midnight on Sunday 16 August.

Due to supplier order deadlines, for any payment made between Monday 17 and Friday 21 August pupils will start their milk provision within two school days.

For our new Lawhead Primary School families, as above, once your child has been enrolled on Wednesday 19 August and you have registered in iPay you will also be able to access the subject milk fund and make payment for pupil milk up to and including Friday 21 August.

Medication - school and nursery

Medications held in school/nursery and related medication paperwork for the next session has come home with your child today. Please complete the appropriate forms and return them, with the necessary medication week ending 21 August 2026.

Please contact the School Office if you require an 'Administration of Medication' or 'Self Administration of Medication' form for a new condition.

Education Health Care Plans and Asthma Care Plans:

For pupils with existing plans in place Mrs Bain will be contacting all parents directly to ensure the plans we currently hold remain accurate. It is the responsibility of parents/carers to notify the school of any changes to their child's current medical care plan.

For pupils who require a new plan to be put in place Mrs Bain will send out draft plans and then ask parents/carers to update the plan with all required information.

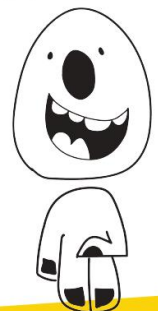
